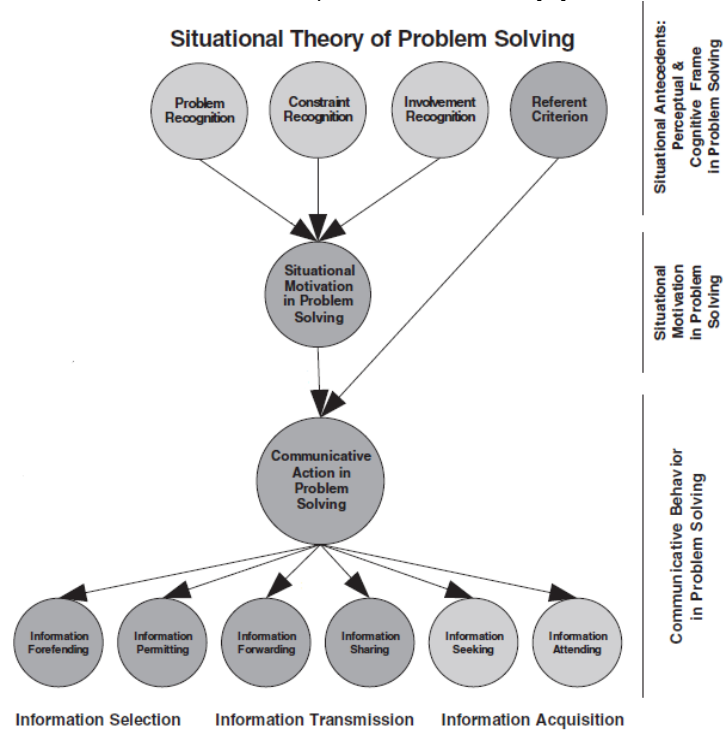


Situation Theory And Its Applications
